As I handed them to him, he became overwhelmed with tears and gratitude, sharing that this was the one good thing that had happened to him in a while.

We know that there is still much more work to do but we remain hopeful. We encourage you to continue to stand with us as Dignity Defenders as we take action to accomplish the extraordinary in 2020.
