About Think Dignity

Mission

Think Dignity is a 501(c)(3) serving San Diego County. Our mission is to advance basic dignity for people experiencing homelessness through our impact programs, Dignity Legal Services, and advocacy campaigns.

History

On October 5, 2006, nine women gathered for dinner to discuss the challenges of homelessness. The ladies passed many of their displaced neighbors on the streets and it was becoming increasingly clear that a few bucks here, a meal there, were only temporarily helpful. They desired a tangible way to restore basic dignity to these individuals and understood these unhoused neighbors were citizens too. Each person had their own story: mothers and fathers, someone's child, a man forgotten after becoming disabled during war. Many endured great tragedy. On that night, our organization was born as Girls Think Tank.

Now named Think Dignity, our organization has grown to include many supporters, and our efforts are reaching the masses through innovative programs and strong regional partnerships. Throughout it all, we've learned that by speaking and acting out, real change occurs.

Programs

Restoring Dignity

Equitable Device Charging: mobile charging units deployed at community outreach events to provide equitable access to charging for accessibility, communication, and medical devices for those experiencing homelessness

Fresh Start Showers: Now administered by our partners at Third Avenue Charitable Organization, mobile shower trailers provide a safe environment for unhoused individuals to practice personal hygiene

ID Bank: assistance obtaining vital documents (birth certificates, IDs & DLs, SS Cards, etc.), including secure hard-copy and electronic storage

Street Boutique: originally designed to combat “period poverty” serving unhoused individuals and victims of abuse, this free pop-up boutique now supports all people obtain socks, undergarments, and hygiene products

Survival Supply Distribution: twice-annual distribution of survival and basic dignity items including hygiene and personal care products, suncare items, clothing, gloves/hats, ponchos, sleeping bags, nonperishable foods, and pet supply items for unhoused individuals in downtown San Diego

Transitional Storage Center: 400 secure lockers and bins provide a safe place for unhoused individuals to store belongings as they transition off the streets

Defending Dignity

Dignity Legal Services: offers supportive, community-centered legal assistance, including expungement services, focused on removing barriers and promoting dignity related to securing housing, employment, and other benefits often unobtainable for those impacted by the justice system

Advancing Dignity

Advocacy Campaigns: public advocacy and community education initiatives aimed at advancing basic dignity for people experiencing homelessness powered by the **Basic Dignity Coalition** — an episodic series of community listening and civic engagement events comprised of those with lived experience of homelessness, service providers, volunteers, and public officials
